Positions Held By MALCOLM LITTLE

[REDACTED] as of
November 11, 1955, MALCOLM LITTLE was the official
Minister of Nation of Islam (NOI) Temple Number 12,
Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and of the Fruit of Islam
(FOI) of this Temple.

[REDACTED]
that the first southern "Goodwill Tour of the
Brotherhood of Islam" was held on Saturday evening,
August 25, 1956, and all day Sunday, August 26, 1956,
in Atlanta, Georgia. He advised that approximately
200 or more members of the Nation of Islam from over
ten cities attended this meeting. He advised that
ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, leader of the Nation of Islam, did
not attend this meeting but was represented by
MALCOLM X of New York City.

[REDACTED] MUHAMMAD never
intended to appear in Atlanta, inasmuch as all
activities were well planned and proceeded like clock-
work under the direction of MALCOLM.

[REDACTED] MALCOLM X is the Minister
of New York City Temple Number 7 of the organization
and was introduced by the Minister of the Atlanta
Temple to deliver the main lecture of the meeting.

[REDACTED] the subject is undoubtedly the number two man in the organization and appears to be a very intelligent, well educated man and is an accomplished orator.
