The "Pittsburgh Courier", a weekly Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, newspaper, November 30, 1957, edition covered an article captioned "Islam Stirs Women In Boston" which states:

"Muhammad's Temple of Islam, 35 Intervale St., was packed to capacity last Wednesday to hear Mrs. Loti Muhammad lecture on 'The Position of Women in Islam.'

"She represented her father, Messenger Elijah Muhammad, noted author and Courier columnist. He is internationally respected as the spiritual head of the fastest growing body of young Moslems in the Western World.

"Speaking for her father, Mrs. Muhammad explained how 'the cradles of all civilizations were first rocked by the hands of our own beautiful black women.'

"Messenger Muhammad is setting up classes throughout America to teach our women the importance of 'our role in life.'

"The speaker was accompanied by her mother, Mrs. Clara Muhammad, wife of Messenger Muhammad, who received a standing ovation. Both were attended by Mrs. Frances X of the New York Moslem Girls' Class, and escorted to Boston by Messenger Muhammad's New York minister, Malcolm X."

Activity at Camden, New Jersey

[redacted] 1957 advised that MALCOLM X of the New York Temple of the NOI visited a meeting of the Camden, New Jersey Temple held on [redacted] in Camden, New Jersey.

Activity in Chicago, Illinois

[redacted] 1957, advised that on that date, an unknown male contacted MALCOLM LITTLE at the residence of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, 4847 South Woodlawn Avenue, Chicago. The individual advised

that he was desirous of talking with MUHAMMAD to which LITTLE replied "we" are too busy.

[redacted] advised that a meeting of the Chicago Temple was held on [redacted] 1957 and MALCOLM LITTLE was one of the speakers. [redacted] advised that MALCOLM spoke of how the so called negro is being treated by the "white devil" and how he is being misled by the white race. LITTLE stated that the negro has his own leader now and does not need help from the "blue eyed white man." b7D

[redacted] advised that a meeting of NOI Temple Number 2, Chicago, Illinois was held on [redacted] 1957 and that MALCOLM LITTLE was one of the speakers. b7D

According to [redacted] LITTLE stated that the American white man has robbed the so called negroes of their rightful names and today the negro in America is without a country, flag, or a name. He stated that negroes are still nothing but slaves in this country and if they do not accept Islam and take their rightful place as rulers of the world, they will all die with the race of the blue eyed devils.

LITTLE continued by saying that the time is coming when the white man's rule will be over and that the so called negro is being treated like a dog in this country. He said that ALLAH sent ELIJAH MUHAMMAD to wake up the negro in North America and to "free the American negro and all other colored persons from the blue eyed devil and destroy them all."

[redacted] went on to state that in his speech LITTLE said that every leader (President) that has been voted into office has promised to help the negro people, but these promises were just lies and no President has done anything for the negro people. He stated that ALLAH is now with them and he is going to destroy all of the white race and the time is now. b7D

[redacted] stated that LITTLE claimed he had recently been in Mobile, Alabama checking on an incident in which two Muslims had been attacked by white policemen. LITTLE stated that he had talked with the Judge in this case who told him that the two Muslims would be released and everything would be alright because they are followers of Islam. LITTLE went on to criticize the Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING as a traitor to the negro people who is being used by the white man to further the white man's aims. He stated that everything the negro people do today benefits the white race only and the white race provides the negro with all types of destructive weapons but does not provide him with anything constructive. b7D

[redacted] 1957, advised that a "Muslim banquet" was held in Chicago, Illinois on [redacted] 1957 in honor of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD. He advised that MALCOLM SHABAZZ spoke at this banquet about his life in crime before ELIJAH MUHAMMAD found him and cleaned him up. b7D

[redacted] 1957 advised that a banquet was held in Chicago, Illinois in honor of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD on [redacted] 1957. [redacted] advised that MALCOLM LITTLE was one of the principle speakers who stated he had "found his own in Islam" and spoke on how the civil rights b7D

of negroes are being violated. He stated that there is a necessity of segregation rather than integration of negroes and whites.

[REDACTED] 1957 advised that MALCOLM X of New York City was introduced at a meeting of the Chicago, Illinois Temple of the NOI held on [REDACTED] 1957. [REDACTED] advised that LITTLE told those in attendance that "visitors" from the east have become seriously interested in the work and teachings of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and recently these visitors came and brought valuable gifts to MUHAMMAD. b7D

[REDACTED] 1958 advised that MALCOLM LITTLE introduced ELIJAH MUHAMMAD at the [REDACTED] 1958 session of the annual NOI Convention held in Chicago, Illinois from February 22 through February 26, 1958. b7D

[REDACTED] 1958 advised that the February 23, 1958 session of the Annual Muslim Convention held in Chicago, Illinois, MALCOLM SHABAZZ was one of the main speakers. He stated that Islam was on the march and that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD is the greatest man since MARCUS GARBY and that MUHAMMAD is sweeping New York, Boston and New Jersey "like a flaming ball of fire." b7D

[REDACTED] 1958 advised that MALCOLM LITTLE spoke at the February 25 session of the Annual Muslim Convention. LITTLE stated that MUHAMMAD was disappointed in the small number of "lost founds" who attended the convention and if he put the wrath of ALLAH on these people it would be a terrible thing. He said that all the brothers should be out at 8:00 the next morning and attempt to get more people b7D

to come to the Temple. He instructed the members to pray to ALLAH to open up the hearts of the people so that MUHAMMAD would not be disappointed again.

[redacted] 1958 advised that LITTLE addressed the February 26, 1958 session of the Annual NOI Convention held in Chicago, Illinois at which time he stated that the negroes "should not worship a man who doesn't look like us, act like us, walk like us or even smell like us." He stated that there are over 17 million negroes in America, but they still had to look to the white man for everything and intimated that if the negroes would unite they could have their own stores and factories and would not be dependent on the white man.

[redacted] 1958 advised that MALCOLM LITTLE spoke at the Annual NOI Convention in Chicago on February 26, 1958 and said that the Holy Apostle ELIJAH MUHAMMAD was very disgusted with the so called negro, that all the members present should go out and get as many people as they could to come to the church. He said that everyone should go in the name of ALLAH and tell the "dead" about the teachings. [redacted] advised that LITTLE then dismissed the meeting for that day.
