[REDACTED] 1957, advised MALCOLM LITTLE continues to hold the post of Minister of Temple No. 7, New York City, although he constantly travels from city to city in the United States, handling various problems for ELIJAH MUHAMMAD of Chicago, Illinois, and making speeches, attempting to recruit additional members. [REDACTED] advised that LITTLE continues to reside at 25-45 99th Street, East Elmhurst, New York, and has no other employment outside the NOI. 67D

[REDACTED] 1957, advised that MALCOLM LITTLE acted as Minister of Temple No. 1, Detroit, Michigan, during [REDACTED] 1957. [REDACTED] stated that, in his opinion, LITTLE is a man who will go ahead in the NOI organization and acts as messenger for ELIJAH MUHAMMAD on various tours throughout the United States. 67D

✓ [REDACTED] 1957, advised that LEMUEL ANDERSON, former Minister of Detroit Temple No. 1 of the NOI, was transferred to the Cincinnati, Ohio, Temple, and MALCOLM LITTLE acted as Minister of the Detroit Temple during September, 1957. [REDACTED] went on to state that LITTLE is well liked in Detroit and the meetings at which he spoke were well attended by NOI members. 67D
