In connection with subject's residence, on [REDACTED] at a meeting of the MGT in NY, on June 25, 1959, an announcement was made that there was a need for a house for the Minister and for ELIJAH MUHAMMAD to use when he comes to New York. Each member was asked to contribute \$25 for this purpose. b7D

[REDACTED] at a NOI meeting on July 5, 1959, in New York, it was announced that there was a need for a house for the Minister. It was explained that Minister LITTLE is going to be important and will need a home to welcome distinguished visitors. b7D

II. POSITION IN THE NOI

At Chicago, Illinois

[REDACTED] at a meeting of NOI Temple #7 in New York, on May 6, 1959, MALCOLM X made the announcements and stated he brought greetings from ELIJAH MUHAMMAD as he had just returned from Chicago. b7D

This information was verified in substance on May 11, 1959, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] MALCOLM LITTLE stated at a NOI meeting in New York, on June 5, 1959, that he had flown to Chicago Wednesday night, June 3, 1959, to confer with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and had returned June 5, 1959. b7D
