Elijah Muhammad, the leader of the Black Muslim group, and his principal Lieutenant, Malcolm X Little, have been feuding since Muhammad silenced Little publicly and officially for making stupid and ill-timed remarks to the effect that the assassination of President Kennedy gave him (Little) pleasure.

Little is probably the most dynamic and forceful Nation of Islam (NOI) spokesman in the movement and the attached memorandum, which is worded in most general terms, could possibly widen the rift between Muhammad and Little and possibly result in Little's expulsion from the NOI.

The information set forth in enclosed memorandum has been the subject of considerable discussion within the NOI and its disclosure will not prejudice our investigation or sources.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the enclosed memorandum be routed to Assistant Director DeLoach for his consideration.
