The [redacted] issue of [redacted] contains an article captioned "Thurmond Assails A Leader Of March". The article stated that, in answer to charges by Senator Strom Thurmond, [redacted] admitted joining the Young Communist League (YCL) in 1936. [redacted] also reportedly stated that he broke completely with the YCL in June, 1941.

The YCL has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

The "Daily Worker", issue of [redacted] contained an article which stated that [redacted] War Resisters League, was one of eight non-communist observers at the Communist Party National Convention in 1957.

The "Daily Worker" was an East Coast Communist newspaper which suspended publication on January 13, 1958.

On March 12, 1964, Malcolm X Little publicly announced the formation of Muslim Mosque, Inc., the philosophy of which will be black nationalism.

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
