[REDACTED] ADVISED THIS DATE THAT SUBJECT ATTENDED ALL DAY MEETING WITH CLARENCE JONES, WHINEY YOUNG, UNKNOWN REPRESENTATIVES OF A. PHILLIP RANDOLPH AND CORE, AND NEGRO ENTERTAINERS SIDNEY POITIER, RUBY DEE, AND OSSIE DAVIS.

[REDACTED] ADVISED THIS DATE ABOVE MEETING CONSISTED OF A DISCUSSION OF GENERAL FUTURE OF CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT IN US. FOLLOWING THE MEETING JONES INDICATED HE CONSIDERED THE BEST IDEA PRESENTED WAS SUBJECT-S IDEA TO INTERNATIONALIZE THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT BY TAKING IT TO THE UNITED NATIONS. JONES FELT IT MAY BE POSSIBLE TO PRESENT IT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY NEXT SEPTEMBER, AND TO LET SUBJECT HANDLE FOREIGN ARRANGEMENTS SINCE QUOTE "HES BEEN THERE."
